### **High School Distance Learning Program (DL) and concurrent Enrolment (CE)** **Contract/Agreement**

The Distance Learning (high school courses) and Concurrent Enrolment (College/tech ed.) programs are offered to provide students with a wider range of course options. Thus those courses which are offered in house are not available as DL/CE choices. Any 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade student needing advanced coursework not offered in the district may take college-level courses.

### **PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY!**

#### **Eligibility (11-12 grade only)**

##### *All Courses*

- Requests are considered on an individual basis.
- A conference with the counselor is required.

##### *Concurrent Enrollment Option*

- Because of the high level of difficulty in college level classes a student should have a B average or higher in courses in the same discipline area as the course they have chosen to pursue.

#### **Guidelines**

- HS courses are available through Colorado Digital Learning Solutions ([www.coloradodls.org](http://www.coloradodls.org))
- College course can be taken through various means, attending a college campus, or online through partner colleges.
- Students may take no more than two courses at a time, during a semester.
- Students can receive both high school and college credit for college level courses.
- High school credit will be denied for any high school or college courses which do not meet graduation requirements in subject, content or grade. Student and/or parent/guardian may appeal to the School Board within 10 days of receiving denial of credit.

#### **Monetary**

- **High School DL course average \$150.00 per course per semester.**
- **College level courses average \$766.50, per course per semester.** This is based on the 17-18 school year cost of \$255.5 per credit hour.
- **VNET (not Spanish) is \$300 or \$350 per semester.**
- Additional charges or further courses will be the responsibility of the student and/or parent/guardian.
- **If the student fails to complete or fails to receive a C or better in a course or program, the student and/or his/her parent/guardian will be required to pay the tuition fee to Kiowa Schools.**
